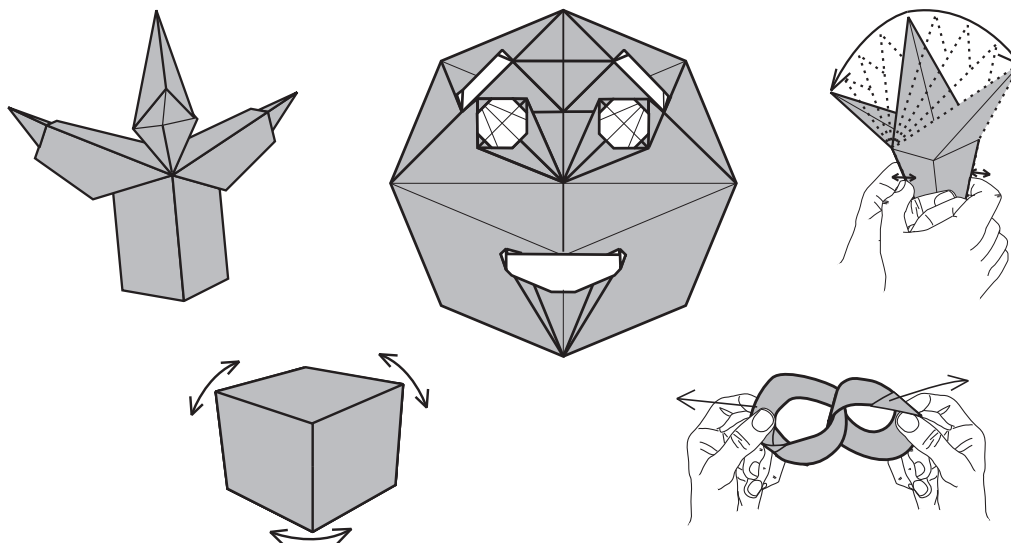


# Bay Area Rapid Folders Newsletter
