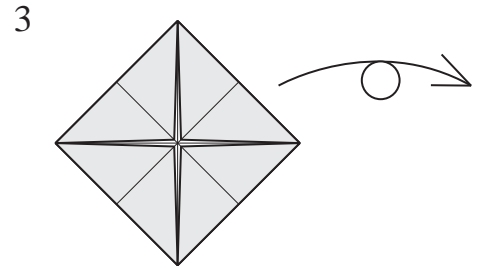
Here's a bell flower that can also be used as a cup, or a hat or a cover for the Eiffel Tower.



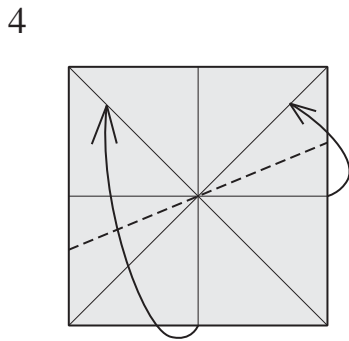
White side up, valley-fold and unfold in half every which way.



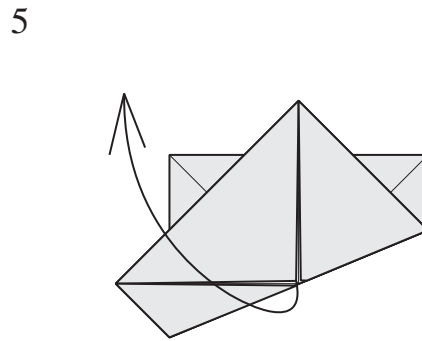
Blintz the four corners.



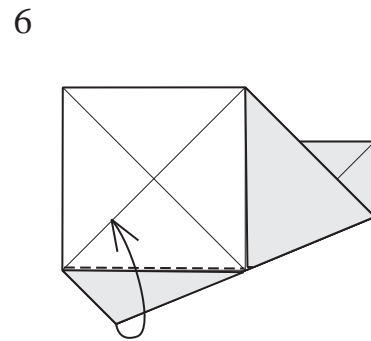
Turn the model over.



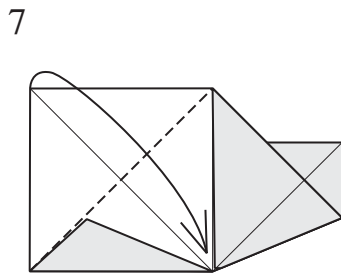
Valley-fold on the center point, crease-to-crease.



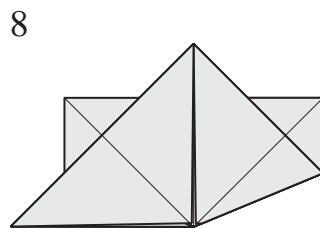
Unfold the flap.



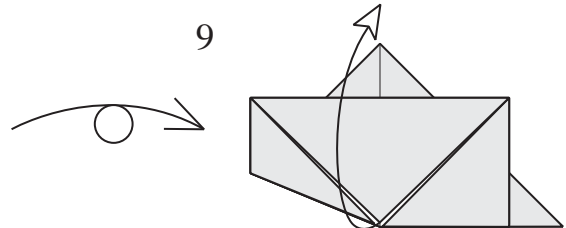
Valley-fold.

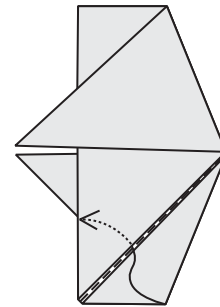
Open the pocket and squash the right-most corner to the left-most corner.

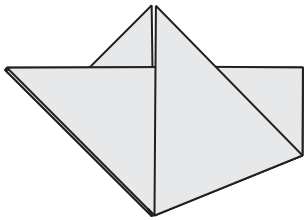

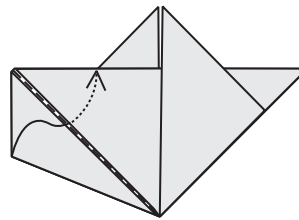
Valley-fold the flap, inserting it into the pocket. Rotate the model 90°.

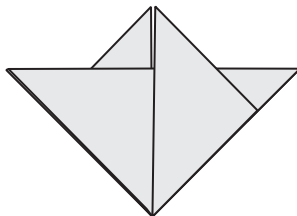

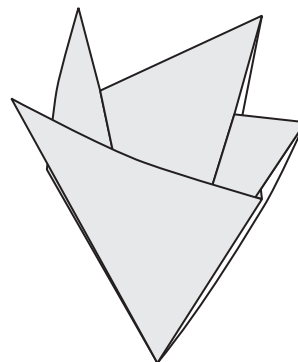
Valley-fold the flap, inserting it into the pocket.
